CCS & CANCELLATION POLICIES

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) applies for eligible families. **CCS will not apply for late pickups beyond 6pm.**

All cancellations must be made with a minimum of 48 hours' notice, excluding weekends and public holidays to avoid charges.

FOOD & DRINK/WHAT TO BRING/WHAT TO WEAR

Please ensure children have packed fruit snack, recess, lunch, drink bottles and **red hats**. **We are unable to heat up food on site.**

Breakfast, afternoon tea (fruit & vegetable platter + occasional extra option) and fresh water will be supplied every day.

Please note we are a nut and egg aware service. Children with life threatening allergies attend our service.

Products containing nuts are **NOT** permitted at the service.

Please ensure your children are dressed in suitable clothing and enclosed shoes. Shoulders must be covered. No tank tops or strappy dresses.

Sunscreen will be provided when UV levels reach 3 or above, as per our sun smart policy. Children are welcome to use their own sunscreen if provided.

MEDICATIONS
