## CCS & CANCELLATION POLICIES

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) applies for eligible families. **CCS will not apply for late pickups beyond 6pm.**

**All cancellations must be made with a minimum of 48 hours' notice, excluding weekends and public holidays to avoid charges. Cancellations of excursions and incursions after the start of week 9 incur a fee of half the daily rate.**

## FOOD & DRINK/WHAT TO BRING/WHAT TO WEAR

Please ensure children have packed fruit snack, recess, lunch, drink bottles and **red hats**. **We are unable to heat up food on site.**

Breakfast, afternoon tea (fruit & vegetable platter + occasional extra option) and fresh water will be supplied every day.

**Please note we are a nut and egg aware service. Children with life threatening allergies attend our service.**

**Products containing nuts and egg are NOT permitted at the service.**

Please ensure your children are dressed in suitable clothing and **enclosed shoes**. Shoulders must be covered. No tank tops or strappy dresses.

Sunscreen will be provided when UV levels reach 3 or above, as per our sun smart policy. Children are welcome to use their own sunscreen if provided. **Red OSHC hats must be worn every day.**

**We are now a SunSmart service. This means that children must wear sun smart clothing at all times while booked in. Covered shoulders, longer style shorts/dresses/skirts (no exposed midriffs) and enclosed shoes to protect feet from skin damage.**
