CCS & CANCELLATION POLICIES

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) applies for eligible families. **CCS will not apply for late pickups beyond 6pm.**

All cancellations must be made with a minimum of 48 hours' notice, excluding weekends and public holidays to avoid charges. Cancellations of excursions and incursions after the start of week 8 incur a fee of half the daily rate, regardless of notice given. Any cancellation outside of the notice period will incur the usual fee.

FOOD & DRINK/WHAT TO BRING/WHAT TO WEAR

Please ensure children have packed fruit snack, recess, lunch, drink bottles and **red hats**. **We are unable to heat up food on site.**

Breakfast, afternoon tea (fruit & vegetable platter + occasional extra option) and fresh water will be supplied every day.

Please note we are a nut aware service. Children with life threatening allergies attend our service.

Products containing nuts are NOT permitted at the service.

We are now a SunSmart service. This means that children must wear sun smart clothing at all times while booked in. Covered shoulders, longer style shorts/dresses/skirts (no exposed midriffs) and enclosed shoes to protect feet from skin damage.
