CCS & CANCELLATION POLICIES

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) applies for eligible families. **CCS will not apply for late pickups beyond 6pm.**

All cancellations must be made with a minimum of 48 hours' notice, excluding weekends and public holidays to avoid charges. Cancellations of excursions and incursions from Monday week 8 incur a fee of half the daily rate, regardless of notice given. Any cancellation outside of the notice period will incur the usual fee.

Please ensure children have packed fruit snack, recess, lunch, drink bottles and **red hats**. **We are unable to heat up food on site.**

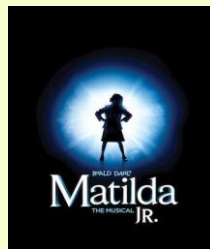
